



# EXPANDED LEARNING

Vaughn Next Century Learning Center's after school programs, ASES and LAs Best, are funded by California State grants. These programs depend on daily student attendance.

The purpose of these programs is to provide an expanded learning opportunity through safe, healthy, and enriching activities beyond the regular school day hours. Currently, Vaughn serves 280 students from grades Kindergarten through 5th grade.

## **PROGRAM CALENDAR**

- Vaughn after school programs follow the school calendar; the program runs for 180 school days
- Program hours start from Vaughn school day dismissal to 6pm.

## **ENROLLMENT**

- Priority enrollment: current participants are given applications in May/June to enroll for the upcoming school year
- Early enrollment: parents/guardians may apply on Vaughn's Compact Signing Day (Saturday before the 1st day of school)
- After school program leaders accept applications all year long
- Students are enrolled until all classes are filled to capacity (per grant regulations)
